

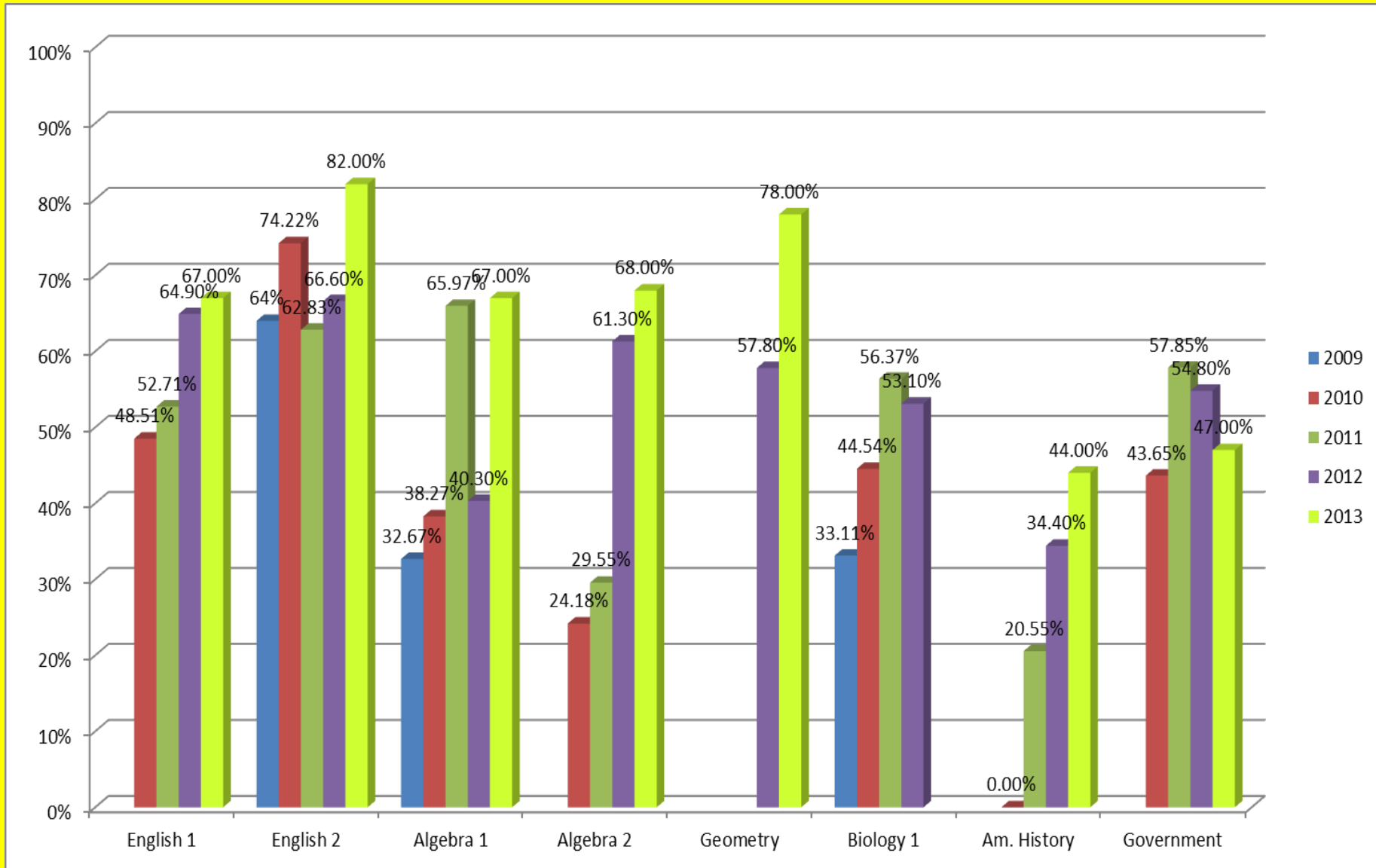

College Prep Diploma

Any Cameron R-1 student who meets the following requirements will be eligible to graduate with the Cameron R-1 College Prep Diploma:

- The student will have completed all of the requirements for the A+ Program.
- The student will have taken at least one class in each of the four core areas for all 4 years of high school.
- The student will have a cumulative GPA of at least 3.0; or have earned an ACT score that is above the Missouri state average.
- The student will have taken the ACT / SAT / ASVAB / or Compass Exam before the 2nd semester of their senior year.
- The student will have taken a minimum of four AP/Dual Credit courses. (for 2015 graduates a minimum of two AP/Dual Credit courses will be required)

A+

- *Get 2 years of community college, junior college, or technical school paid for if you meet the following requirements...*
- Sign A+ Agreement in the Fall
- Graduate with a 2.5 GPA or higher
- Perform 50 hours of tutoring
- Maintain a 95% attendance average over 4 years of high school
- Maintain a record of good citizenship
- Avoid unlawful use of drugs and alcohol
- Attend an A+ high school for 3 years
- Must score proficient or advanced on Algebra I EOC (beginning with class of 2015)

Academic Banquet

- Banquet will be Monday, November 4th at 6:30 to honor and award academic letters to students who met the requirements. (Took 4 in the Core and had a minimum GPA of 3.2)

On-Line Dual Credit Classroom

- Junior and Senior students will be able to enroll in and take an on-line dual credit class during the school day.
- Working with UCM, MWSU, and Central Methodist so far; could add more.
- Cost will be about half of what normal college tuition is.
- Will be in place at the start of the 2014-2015 school-year.

Feb. 6th Parent-Teacher Conferences

- Your student's Seminar teacher will be calling to set up an appointment time for you on that day.
- You will go over your student's 4 year plan and then enroll for the 2014-2015 school-year with your student's Seminar teacher.
- Your student will have the same Seminar teacher all 4years at CHS.

Possible Drug Testing Policy???

- Drug abuse is a serious problem, Cameron R-I is not immune.
- Goal would not be to levy discipline, but rather to aid in discovery and prevention of possible drug-related problems.
- The program would be mandatory to all participating in any school sponsored extra-curricular activities, and those students who drive to school.
- Testing would be random and conducted by an independent lab which the district would contract with.
- School Board would help develop policy to ensure that aspects of the policy are in compliance with MSBA
