End of the Year Calendar!

- May 9, 2018:** Final grades due for Seniors.
- May 11, 2018:** Senior locker clean out. Report to 1st hour and you will be dismissed from class by intercom. Decision Day Celebration at YMCA 10-2 p.m. An announcement will be made when it is time to board the busses. The exit survey link will be emailed to your school email address on this day.
- May 14, 2018:** **LAST DAY FOR SENIORS! Bring your cap and gown to school**
- Seniors – 8:00 a.m. report to the Library. Attendance will be taken there.
 - Senior Recognition – 8:30 a.m. at the High School (gymnasium)
 - Seniors – dress attire is business casual – NO Jean or t-shirts.
 - Parents are invited to attend. They may enter through the commons. Limited parking will be available for parents and guests in the lower parking lot or along the street.
 - Indoor Graduation Practice – will be immediately following Recognition
 - Senior Class Picture – time will be allowed for changing into your cap & gown.
 - Outdoor Graduation Practice - immediately following pictures report to the football field.
 - Senior Class Lunch – will be served at the football field after practice.

Office hours will be 8-12 and 1-3 each day (closed 5/28 for Memorial Day)
